ALL SECURE

TOC Europe will be following the Informa **AllSecure Guidelines** to deliver a safe event. AllSecure is comprised of a detailed set of enhanced measures to provide the highest levels of hygiene and safety, detailed information on the guidelines can be found on page 3.





BETTER STANDS

At Informa Markets, **Better Stands** will target disposable stands replacing them with higher-quality reusable structures made with sustainable materials. New stand build regulations will be in place for TOC Europe 2021, more information on page 6.

STAND CAPACITY

To support social distancing and keep everyone safe, all stands are required to display the maximum stand capacity on the outside of their stand.

As an exhibitor it is your responsibility to balance stand staff and visitor at all times. We recommend planning meetings with clients in advance to manage stand capacity, further information on stand capacity can be found on page 4.





HEIGHT LIMIT ON STAND

The maximum height of a space only stand is 4m, no double decker stands are permitted.

REGISTRATION & BADGES

Online registration for all exhibition staff, contractors and visitors must be completed prior to arriving onsite. For safety reasons, no onsite registration will be permitted. Self scanning machines will be at the entrance to the halls and in all catering areas. Please see page 5 for additional information on onsite guidelines.


TOC Europe will be organised in accordance with Informa's AllSecure health and safety standard. As the world's leading events' organiser, Informa has developed a detailed set of enhanced measures to provide the highest levels of hygiene and safety at its events, providing everyone with reassurance and confidence they are participating in a safe and controlled environment.

Placing your safety at the heart of our events

When you join our event, you can expect to see that health and safety is a priority, and that a range of measures are in place to ensure everyone involved is able to enjoy a safe, hygienic, productive and high-quality organised event experience.

All Informa events will be run according to official government and local authority guidance in the first instance, as well as any venue or location-specific regulations. In addition, all Informa events will follow the ten Informa AllSecure priority commitments. Wherever applicable and possible, our events will also apply the fuller range of standards and guidelines described in the Informa AllSecure guidebook.

Please review the following information with guidance on stand build, stand capacity & what to expect at TOC Europe 2021.



STAND LAYOUT & CAPACITIES

- ✓ Keep your design simple, to maximise open space & help visitors maintain social distancing
- A maximum of 40% of stand area may be covered by stand elements (e.g structure, furniture and products)
- ✓ The maximum height of any stand is 4m no double decker stands will be permitted.
- ✓ Layout must satisfy hygiene & physical distancing requirements
- ✓ Plan your stand with clearly marked entry and exit where possible
- Minimise physical touch points, physical products and shared equipment. Suitable structural measures (e.g perspex glass screens) & personal protective equipment (PPE; face covering & gloves) must be taken when minimum distancing can not be observed
- Exhibits, display cases, counters, displays, screens, etc. should be located inside the stand so visitors can leave the aisle to view them on the stand
- The maximum number of individuals allowed in your stand (this includes you as an exhibitor as well as visitors), at any point in time must follow local physical distancing requirements
- Balance the on-stand customer and exhibiting staff total capacity, at given point during show days
- ✓ Display the maximum capacity number visibly on your stand
- ✓ On-stand physical distancing must not supersede guidance set out below:

ONSITE GUIDELINES

- Registration for all exhibitors, contractors and visitors should be completed prior to arriving onsite
- ✓ Upon completing registration you will receive a badge
- ✓ Self-service scanning of badge for entry & exit
- ✓ One-way systems will be in place throughout the halls
- ✓ Face covering must be worn at all times (including build, show open & breakdown)
- ✓ Refrain from handshakes and embraces & observe social distance at all times
- ✓ Hand washing stations & anti-bacterial gel dispensers will be available throughout the
 halls
- ✓ Observe maximum capacities on stands & feature areas
- Catering outlets will only take contactless payment, no cash

As a part of our **Better Stands** programme we will work towards replacing disposable stands with higher-quality reusable structures made with sustainable materials.



To promote Better Stands, we are implementing key changes to our stand construction regulations. We are asking all exhibitors to work with their appointed contractor to design a stand which has a core structure that is made from reusable or recyclable materials. Stand contractors should include details of materials within the submitted stand design and build methodology that will be approved by our official Health and Safety partner, Abraxys,
