




THE SUEZ CANAL ROUTE, A VITAL SHORTCUT FOR THE GLOBAL TRADE

SGTD Doraleh Terminal – Port investment - decisive factor of country and regional development




- Port & Logistics investments boost economy growth. 2005/2019 (15 years): ETH/Djib Invest in Ports & Logs (10G\$), GDP growth: X 7 times!
- Port development; job creation in number, qualified and sustainable
- Development of free zones and corridors activities
- Encourage the infrastructure development, along the corridor
- Increase hinterland Export competitiveness
- Limitation of the freight and handling cost of Import for local and hinterland business
- Facilitate the regional economic integration: exemple of Djibouti / Ethiopia (Port, Telecom, Water, Power...)
- Idem at Mombasa Port / Uganda, Kenya development




