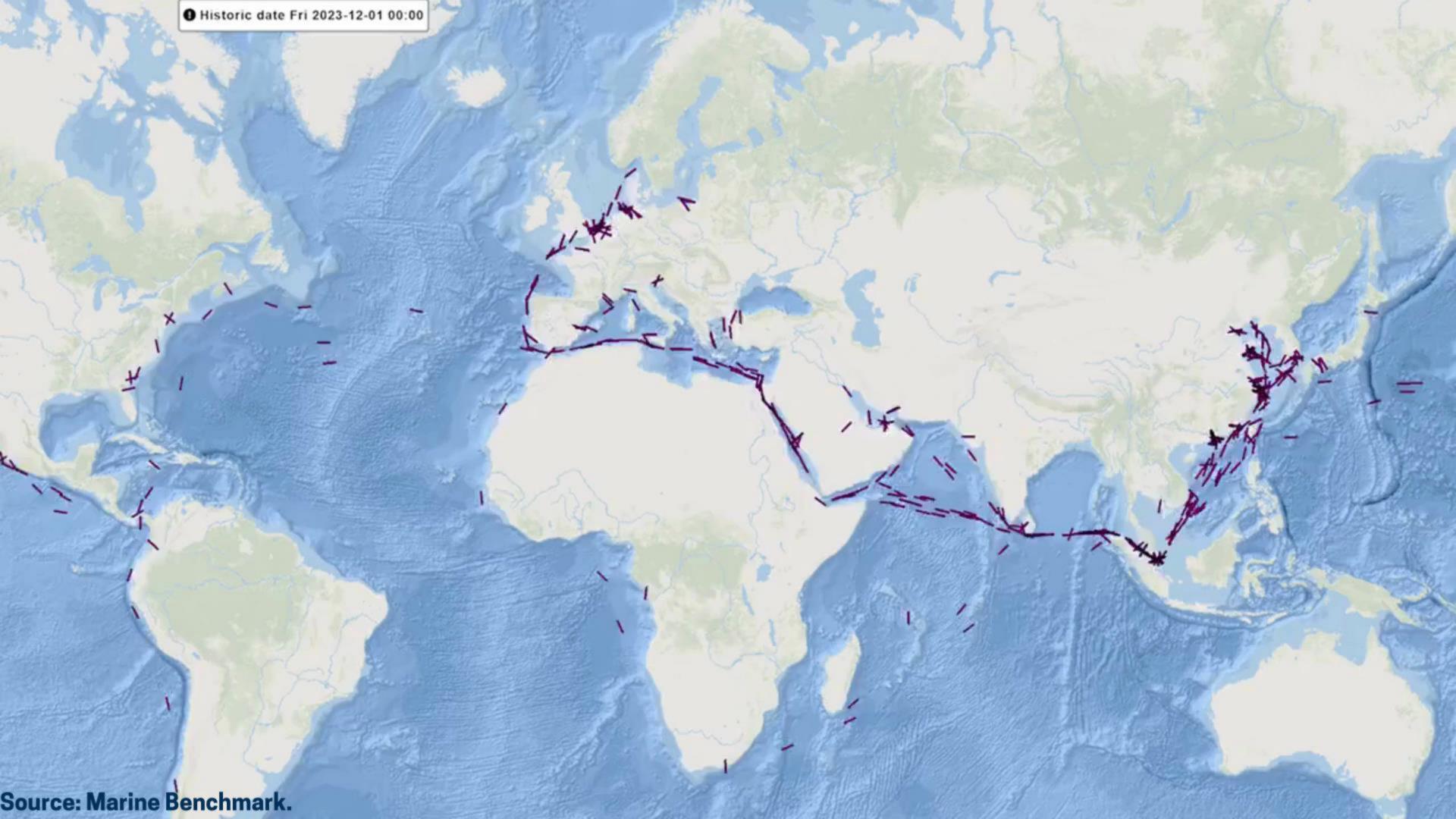

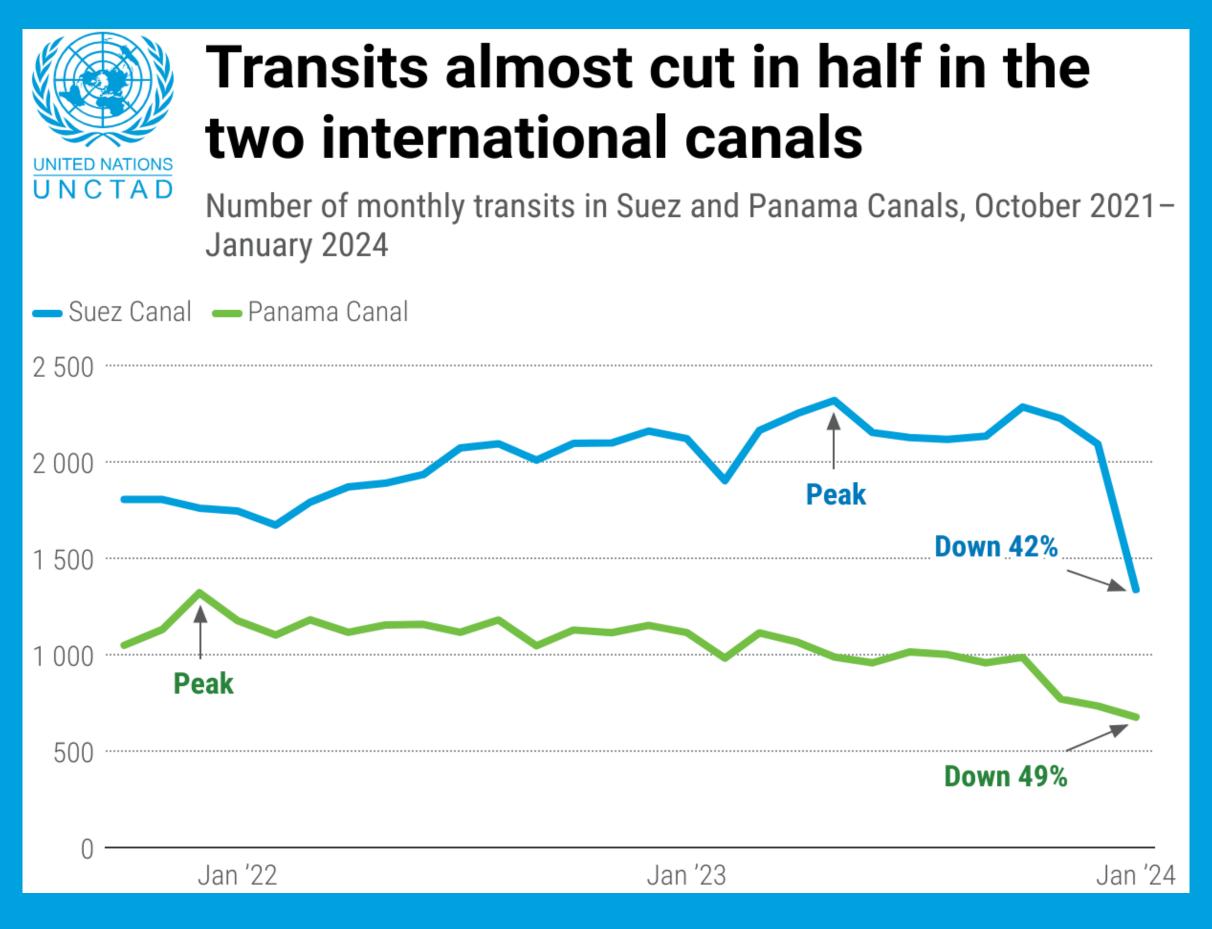

# Number of calls in Sub Saharan Africa ports as a result of disruption



#### Calls in Sub Saharan Africa

- Prior to Red Sea disruption, 5 weekly calls
- Post Red Sea disruption, 20 weekly calls

#### Vessels passing with no calls:

- Prior to Red Sea disruption, 20 weekly vessels
- Post Red Sea disruption, 650 weekly vessels

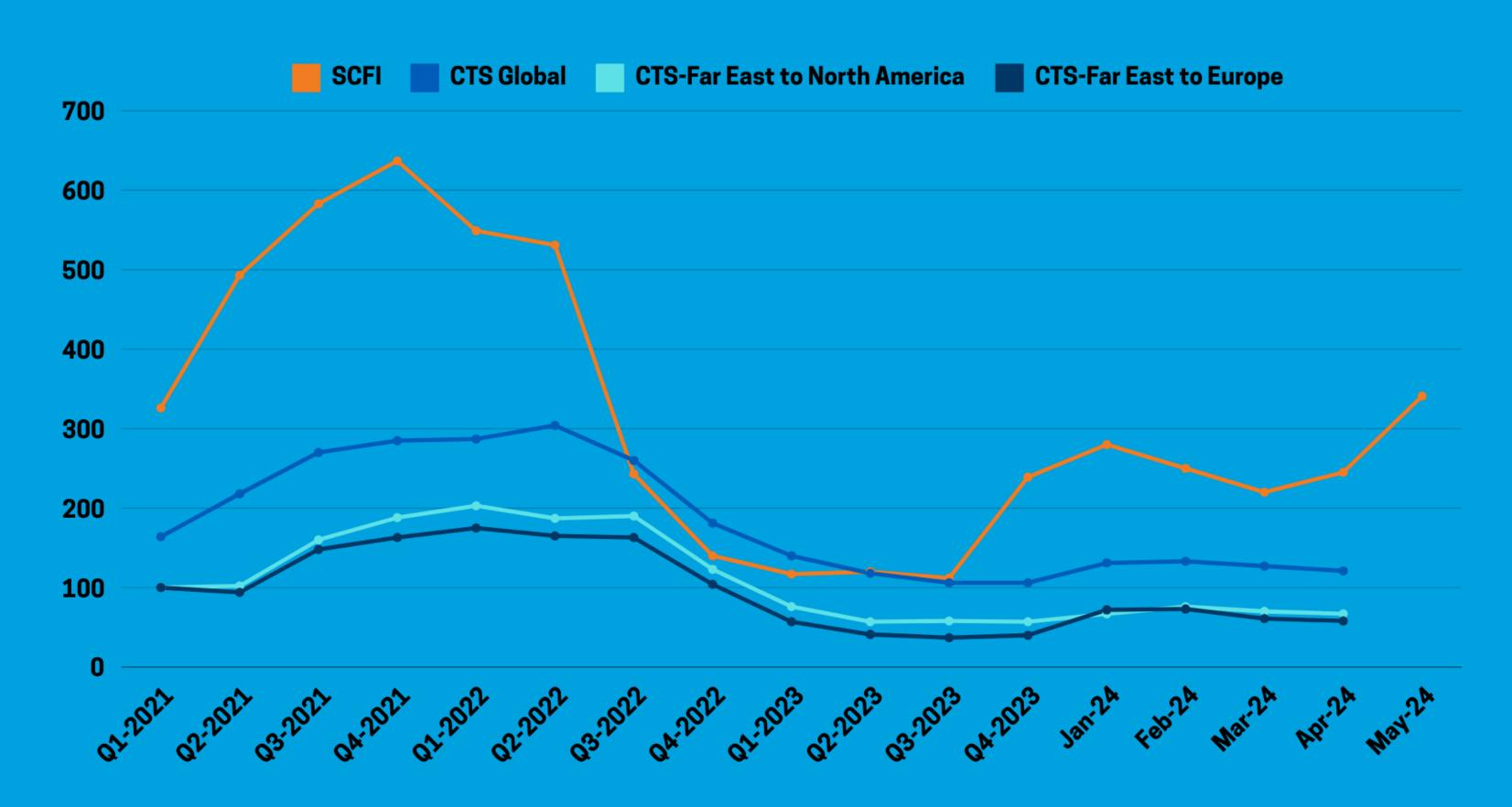
Limited opportunity at present to attract vessels to stop.

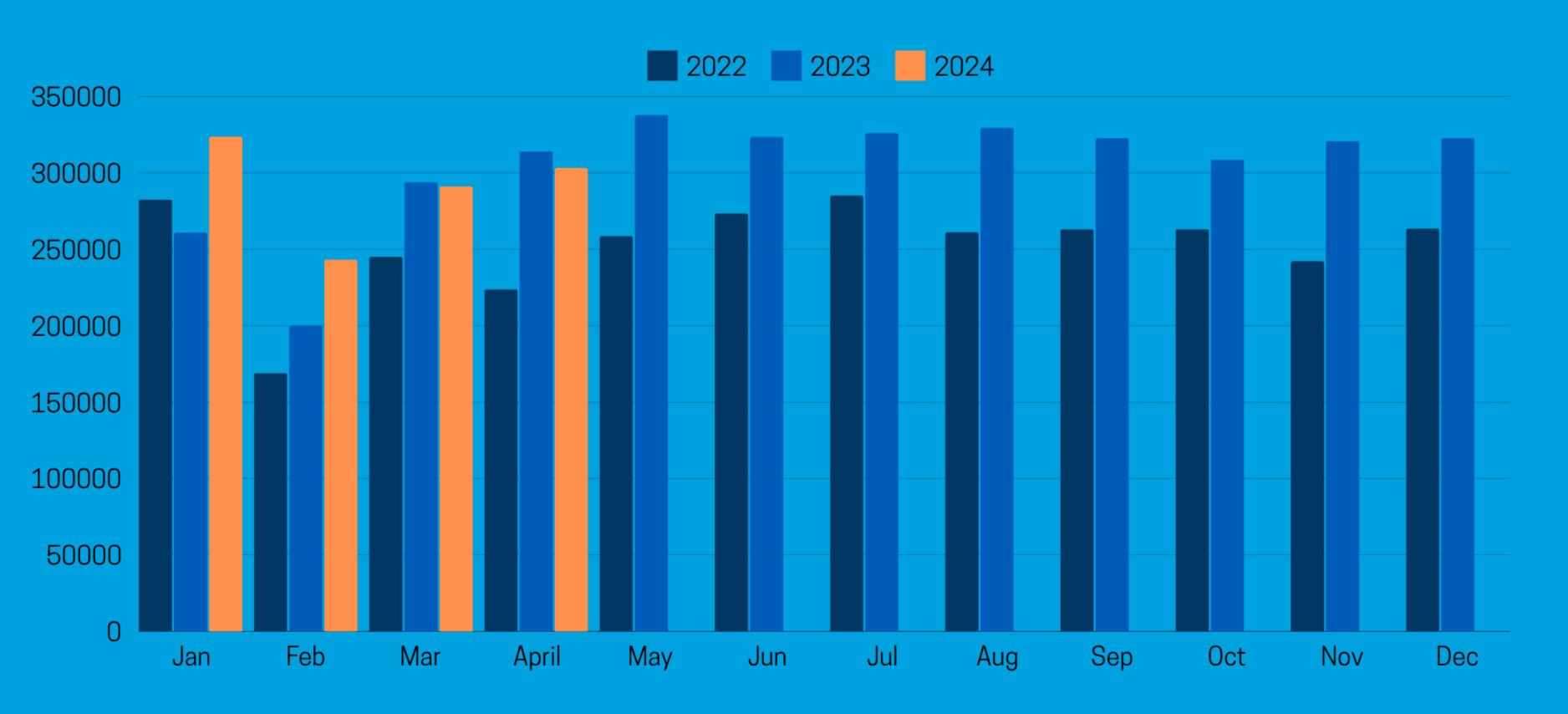
## SCFI vs CTS Freight Rates





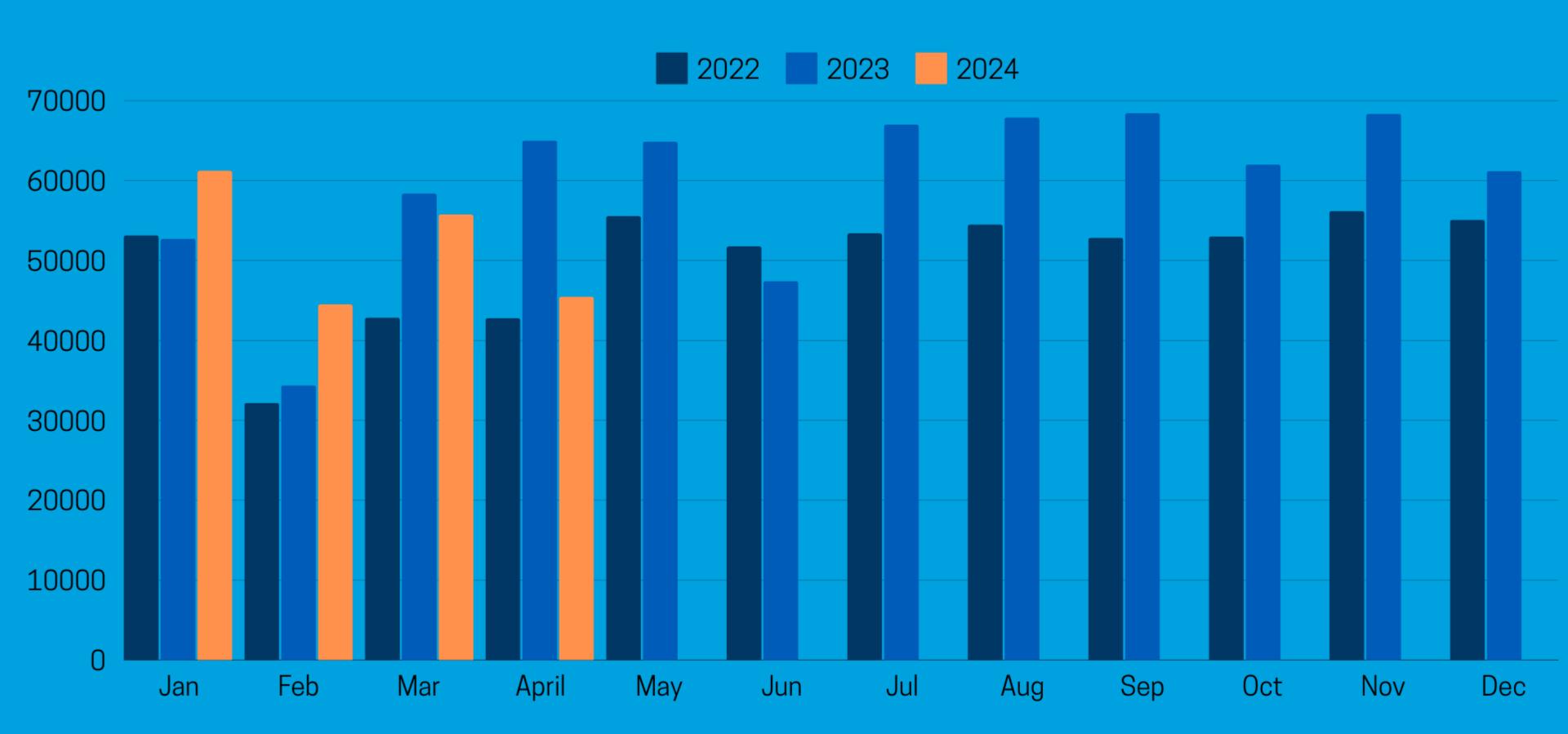
# Asian Volumes to Sub Saharan Africa 2022-2024





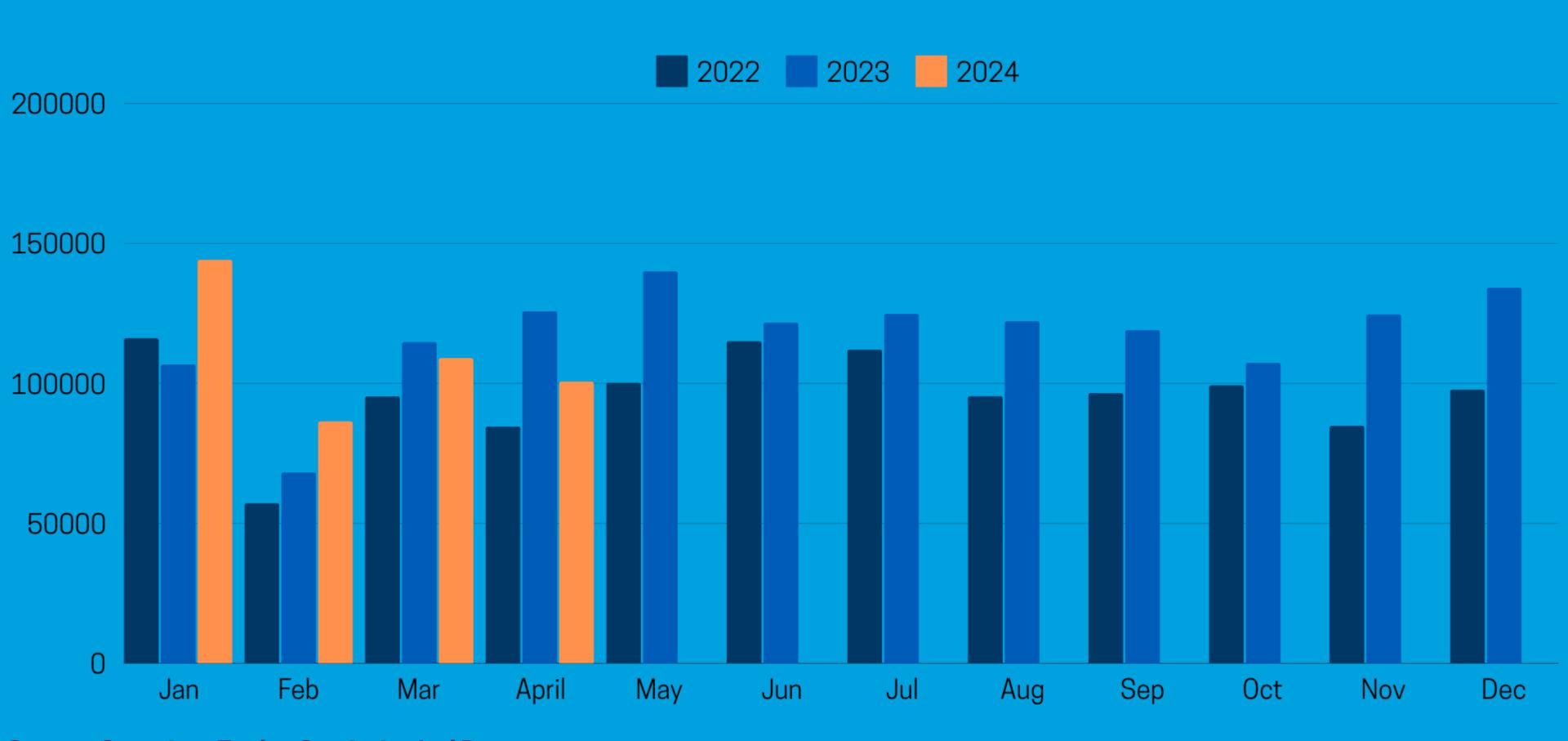
# Greater China Volumes to East Africa 2022-2024





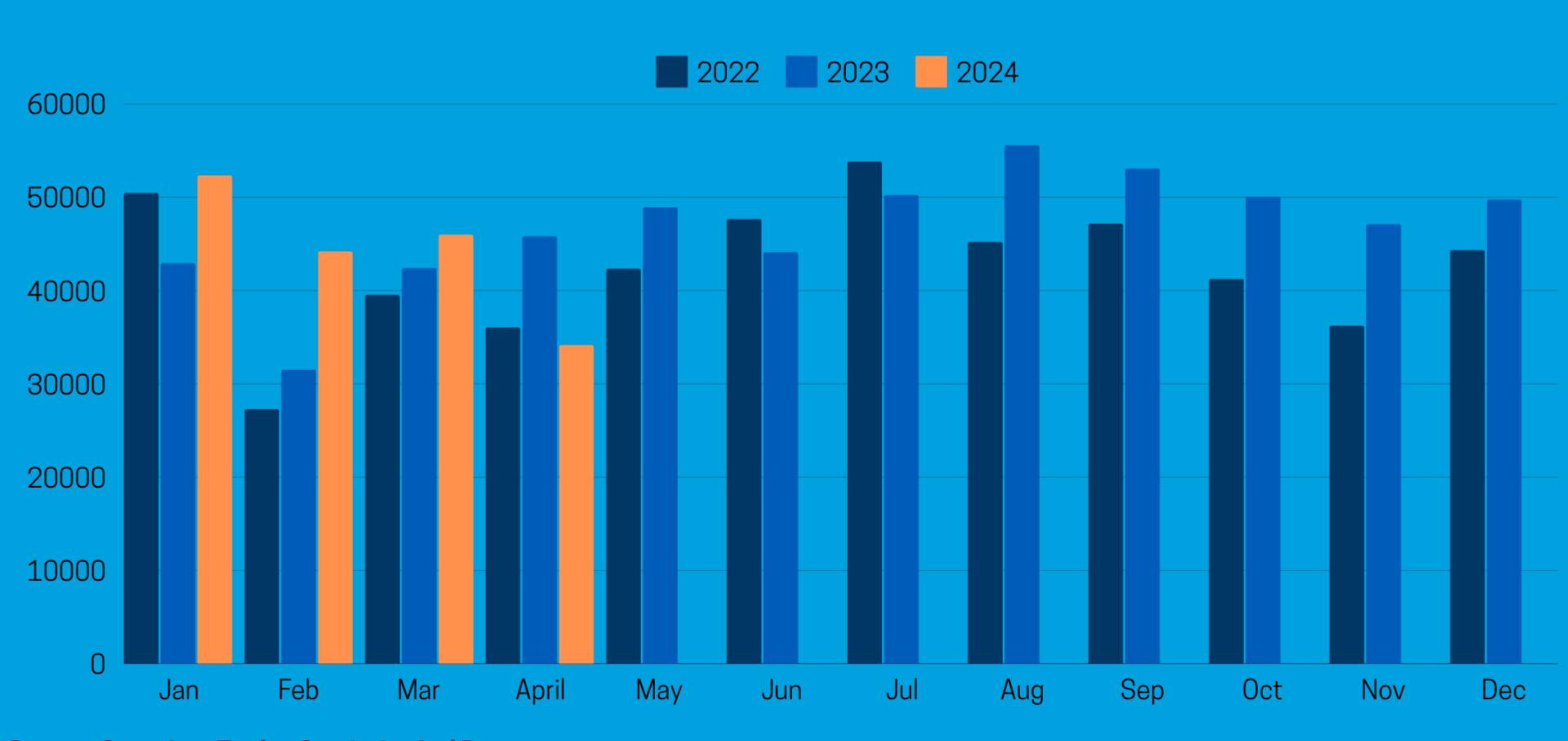
### Greater China Volumes to West Africa 2022-2024

# Nearshoring & Transshipment Opportunities



- Opportunities for ports will rely on them having a competitive advantage:
  - Intra regional hub requires significant investment
  - New Bunker opportunity for new low carbon fuels
  - Inland delivery hub providing fast overland routes.
- Near shoring -longer term
- Despite much noise, little evidence of significant investment it would require:
  - Economic advantage with freight levels remaining high in medium term
  - Significant investment in processing capacity or manufacturing
  - Governmental policy to encourage such investments.



### Conclusions

- Sub Saharan Africa has seen a huge increase in container shipping activity but little impact on local ports.
- The lengthening of the supply routes has tightened the asset usage and absorbed the over capacity to the point of significant freight level increases.
- On a positive side, trade levels to all areas have surged with West and East Africa showing high imports from Greater China.
- Transshipment opportunities only available for intra regional cargo or Decarbonised fuel opportunities.
- Near Shoring a longer-term investment scenario not likely to have short term opportunistic gains.
